Information for Judoka and Parents

- Licences of any Judoka wishing to Grade must **be submitted to the Grading Officer within the Grading Check-in times indicated above**. All licences **must be in date, have a photo and the personal details completed**.
- If according to the BJC Database on the day of the Grading a Judoka presents wishing to grade and needs to upgrade their Provisional Licences to a Full Licences, or their Full Licence needs renewing, this **must** be paid to the Grading Officer **prior to commencing – NO EXCEPTIONS**.
- All Judogi **must** comply with BJC Regulations – if you have any questions regarding this please talk to your Club Instructors.
- All entries should come from recognised BJC Clubs - Mat fees will be collected by the Club Representatives and submitted to the Area Treasurer or his nominated deputy at the end of the Grading. Cheques should be made payable to Avon Area BJC.
- Any judoka from outside the Avon Area must submit their licence and pay the Grading fee when checking in.
- **The Avon Area Grading Syllabus will be used to assess all judoka. Copies are available in advance if required.**
- All 3rd Kyu's and above will attend with the Techniques required for their next grade signed off by a Dan Grade Registered BJC Coach on an Avon Area / BJC Grading Sheet. Any Kata required must be demonstrated on the day unless pre-qualified with either the Area Grading Officer, Area Kata Coach or Area Technical Officer and the appropriate signed and dated BJC Kata Sheet(s) submitted. Please note any Techniques and Kata can be requested on the day of the Grading at the Grading Officers / Technical Officers discretion.
- **All green belts within the Avon Area are encouraged to attend even if they do not wish to Grade to allow the opportunity to those who do.**

Any complaints by parents or judoka participating in the Grading should initially be directed to, and dealt with, by the Club Representative. The Club Representative will then bring any outstanding concerns or complaints to the attention of the Grading Officer, Technical Office and Senior Grade as appropriate.

Notes for all Club Instructors & Coaches

Pre-grading briefing for all Grading Assessors and Assistance will take place at 09:45.

We would like to encourage any Senior 2nd Kyu and above within the Avon Area that are Registered BJC Coaches or have completed FPJ 1 or above and have been DBS checked by the British Judo Council to assist at this Grading.
